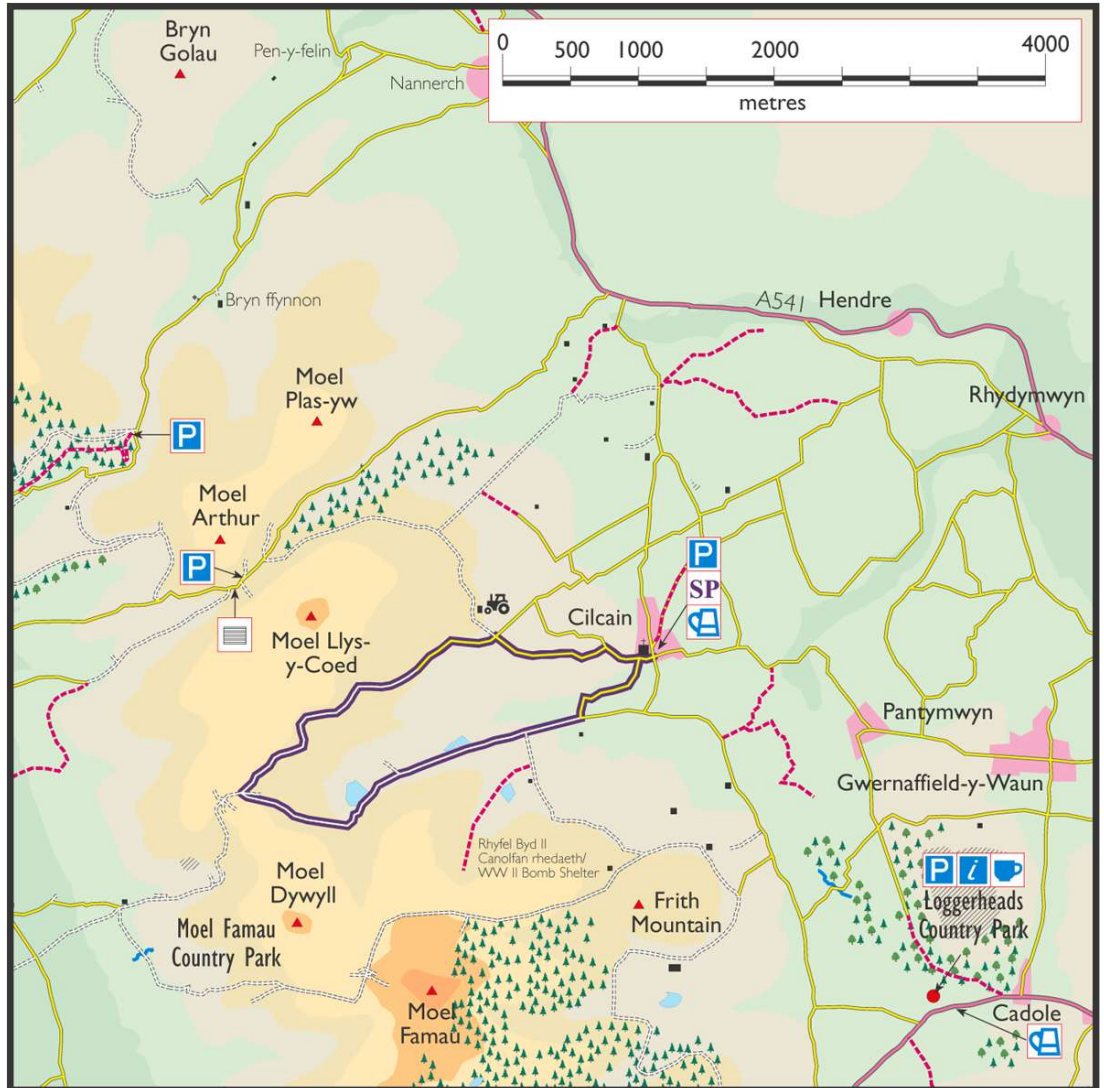

Symbol	Description	Distance (Km)
SP	Car Park opposite church. Turn right out of car park and bear right at immediate junction. Turn left at T-junction, up short, steep climb.	1.05
	Continue straight across crossroads.	1.5
	Road becomes unsurfaced, continue through gates, up steady climb.	2.3
	Just before crest of climb, double back left on marked singletrack bridleway. (For great views continue to ridge, straight on.)	4.1
	Cross over small stream and follow path bearing left.	5.2
	Pass through small gate, and turn right onto track.	5.7
	Follow track past reservoirs on left, until reaching tarmac road. Turn left onto road, up short climb.	7.3
	Turn right at junction, back to start point.	8.2
